## Information regarding children receiving Confirmation and First Communion

It is important for you to know that the Diocese of Victoria, unlike many Dioceses across Cananda and other places in the world, follows the Restored Order in regard to these sacrament as requested by Pope Francis and the Holy See.

This means that the sacrament preparation program at St Peter's is a two-year program. First year, no matter the age, all children will be learning about the Bible, the Catholic Faith and tradition, and prepare for the Sacrament of Reconciliation. In their second year, they will be journeying deeper into their faith education by preparing to receive **both** sacraments of Confirmation and First Communion at the end of the school year.

Please note, we understand all family's situations and a child's previous religious education experiences are different. Due to this, we want to learn about all your child's pervious educational background so we can place them in the correct 'year', whether it be starting in first year or second. So, if you have any questions regarding where exactly your child would fit within this program,( or if you have any questions about the program in general), please contact Natasha Ossa through the Parish Office

Finally, Father Harrison would like all families to know that, upon signing your child up for Sacramental prep classes, you also need to register and attend the Parish Family Events. These events are considered an extension to their sacramental prep classes and all parents and children are required to all 5 Family Events throughout the year.
